

Building Global Research from Southeast Asia: Bidding for Grants

Mark Johnson, from Goldsmiths, will present a special grants session on 'building global research from Southeast Asia'. Mark is Principal Investigator (PI) of the UK Arts & Humanities Research Council's £3.2 million project entitled Global GRACE (Global Gender and Cultures of Equality).

Mark's work is on sexuality and migration in the Philippines and Filipino diaspora, and he will use this session to talk through, first, what funding councils such as the AHRC are looking for in Global Challenges Research Fund projects and, secondly, how to put a competitive bid together using Southeast Asian connections.
